






United by a Commitment to Philanthropy

Soft, Magnetic Doors Provide Safety and Privacy

As the Behavioral Health team continues to work to create safer and more aesthetically pleasing patient care environments, soft doors have been installed in the bathrooms in the inpatient Behavioral Health and the Emergency Psychiatric Assessment, Treatment and Healing (EmPATH) Units.

This unique style of door is hinge-free and works with internal magnets that attach to the door's steel frame. These "suicide-safe" doors provide privacy and dignity within the patient's room environment. This new Joint Commission requirement is considered the gold standard for Inpatient Behavioral Health bathroom doors.

The door design options also provide a calming oasis within the patient's room with images as shown in photos. Our

patients and families have expressed appreciation for the uniqueness, safety, and touch of nature during distressing times.

Providing Training and Education to Amish Birth Attendants

CentraCare - Long Prairie partnered with Astera Health, area Certified Nurse Midwives and three Public Health departments to host training sessions in Long Prairie, Wadena and Bertha focused on enhancing home birth safety within the Amish community.

The six goals for this training were to:

- 1. Improve confidence and safety of Amish birth attendants.
- 2. Provide guidelines for home birth safety and when to ask for help.
- 3. Teach advanced skills for home birth attendants.
- 4. Advise about nutrition during pregnancy.
- 5. Provide information that a medical professional will want/need when calling for advice or asking for help.
- 6. Identify what before-birth care is most important to increase the

likelihood of a safe, home birth.

Long-time CentraCare physician, Paul Van Gorp, MD, worked with Robin Colbern, CNM; Anna Miller, CPM; and Ashley Briner, CNM and Todd, Wadena and Ottertail's departments of Public Health to create a reference manual containing useful information and guidelines that was provided to each attendee.

"These educational sessions were well received by the Amish community who often do not seek prenatal, birth or post-partum care due to the cost," said Dr. Van Gorp. "By partnering with other organizations, we

were able to educate them in an effort to increase the likelihood of a safe, home birth."

CentraCare Foundation provided funding to cover the costs associated with these education sessions.
